The age of majority is 18

Due to a revision of the civil code, from Apr 01, 2022, the age of majority will lower from 20 to 18 years of age. Once anyone becomes 18, they will be the age of majority.

Upon becoming the age of majority, one can enter contracts of their own free will, without parental permission. However, it is possible for young people, with less social experience, to be harmed by malicious businesses. When entering contracts, exercise extreme care and responsibility in your actions. Starting in February Municipal and Prefectural Residence Tax Declaration for FY 2023

From February, City Hall and branch offices will begin accepting Municipal and Prefectural residence tax declarations for the 2023 fiscal year.

This year, we will begin accepting declarations at branch offices earlier than usual. Refer to the table on the right for more details.

To prevent the spread of COVID–19 and avoid congestion, we would appreciate anyone who can submit their declaration via post.

Age requirement for tax exemption of minors has been lowered

The constitutional age of majority has been lowered from 20 to 18 years old. Beginning from January 1, 2023, those of 18 and 19 years of age will no longer be considered as minors within the prefectural and municipal residence tax systems.

Announcement Regarding Tax Returns from the Tax Agency

You can create income tax return forms simply and without any calculation mistakes on the National Tax Agency's website (search 確定申告 書等作成コーナー). In addition, e-Tax (electronic declaration), is a simple, efficient, and safe way to declare taxes.

Merits of submitting tax returns via e-Tax

► Avoid congested tax offices! (and COVID-19)

► Minimize documents required for submission! (may have to submit in some cases)

▶ You can submit your declaration 24/7 during the declaration period.

▶ You can receive your tax refund far quicker than by paper submission! (returned within 3 weeks)

National Pension at 20 years old

The national pension system was made so that those of working age can come together and support fellow citizens who have aged, or become sick and injured.

Those living in Japan, who are over the age of 20 and below 60, are required to join the pension system. Insured members are separated into three types.

[1st Insured Type] Student, self-employed, unemployed, etc.

[2nd Insured Type] Company employee, public official, etc.

[3rd Insured Type] Spouses provided for by those of the 2nd insured type.

★ The monthly insurance premium for FY 2022 is ¥ 16,590. There is a payment exemption and postponement system for students, or those who find

it difficult to pay. Please discuss with the pension desk.

Advanced payments are cheaper for insurance premiums!

You can recieve a discounted price by paying your insurance premiums in advance. The discount increases if you pay in advance via bank transfer.
