## Child Healthcare Support extended to the end of the fiscal year (March) in which you turn 18 years old

From Aug 1, 2023, the scope of eligibility for Child Healthcare Support will be expanded. **Inquiries:** Child and Family Division **☎** 435-1219

Period	Eligibility (must have an address in Wakayama City)	
Present	Until middle school graduation	
From August 1, 2023	Until March 31st following your 18th birthday (Those born between Apr 02, 2005~Apr 01 2008 will become eligible)	

From early April, we will sequentially send announcements regarding the Child Health Care Support System and a confirmation form. To those who need to apply, we will also send an application form. Finally, we plan to send Certificates of Entitlement in late July. Please contact us if you have yet to receive the certificate in August. Those who already receive other medical expense subsidies do not need to apply.

**3 Please wear a helmet while cycling Inquiries:** Regional Safety Division **3**435-1005

From April 1, in accordance to a revision of the Road Traffic Act, it will become a "compulsory effort" to wear helmets on bicycles. According to national data from the previous 5 years regarding accidents involving injury or death, the fatality rate of riders without helmets is 2.2x more than those with helmets. Please wear a helmet.

#### Five Rules for Safe Cycling

①As a general rule, ride on the left side of the road. Sidewalks are an exception, but you should prioritize pedestrians.

【When to use the sidewalk】(1)When there is a "passable sidewalk" (歩道通行可) sign → (2)those who are under 13; are 70 and above; or have limited mobility (3), when cycling on the road is dangerous.



②Confirm the safety of your surroundings, and traffic lights and stop signs at intersections.

③Use a light at nighttime.

4Drinking and driving is prohibited. Criminal punishment for intoxicated driving: up to 5 years of imprisonment, or a 1,000,000 \( \) fine.

(5)Wear a helmet.

#### Real estate inspection for property taxes

Personnel will conduct inspections at houses that were newly built in 2023. We appreciate your cooperation in advance. Newly built houses may be applicable for property tax reductions. Please inquire about specifics of during your home inspection.

Houses that have conducted certain upgrades, (earthquake resistant • barrier free • energy saving (\*\*1) renovations etc.) may also be applicable for such reductions.

In the case that your house has been demolished, be sure to contact the Property Tax Division.

(\*1) Windows are required to receive thermal insulation upgrades.

(\*2)Please apply within three months after the renovations have been completed.

# FY2023 City-sponsored Japanese Language Classes for Non-Native Speakers (1<sup>st</sup> Term)

The City of Wakayama will be offering Japanese language classes to non-native speakers, who live or work in Wakayama City. Because the classes will be held at night, people who work during the day can also participate. You can choose either the Introductory course or the Beginner's course, according to your ability.

Introductory Course: This course begins with hiragana and katakana.

**Beginner's Course:** This course is for people who already know hiragana, katakana and simple grammar (verbs, adjectives, normal form of adjectival verbs), but want to learn more difficult grammar. It is the continuation of the Introductory course; however, previous completion of the Introductory course is not required.

- \*Please bring your own pencil, eraser, pen, notebook, etc. to class.
- \*Classes will be cancelled if heavy rain/strong wind warnings are issued as of 1500 on the day of the class.
