

TOMOGASHIMA LIGHTHOUSE
It is a Western-style architectural lighthouse made in 1872. It is still in operation.



MERIDIAN SQUARE
It is a square where the Japan Standard Time Meridian passes in the square of the western side of Tomogashima Lighthouse.

There is a tide pool, which is suitable for observation of shellfish companions, crabs, small fish etc.



THIRD FORT RUINS
There are six fort ruins used in the island until the end of World War II, among them the largest scale.

Tomogashima Third Battery, together with the other 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th Batteries in the island and Torajima Fallow, the Meiji government, for the purpose of defense of the Kitan Strait, it is one of the Yura fortresses built in the Yura area (Awaji Island), Tomogashima, Kada, Miyama district.

SHINJAIKE POND
Wetland plant communities such as Cladium chinense Nees and Cyclosorus interruptus are growing and are designated as natural monuments in Wakayama Prefecture.



MINAMI TARUMI CAMP GROUND
It is a lawn-covered square, suitable for camping and recreation.



TAKANOSUYAMA OBSERVATORY
Overlooking the Kitan strait under the eyes, you can also see the mountains in the Shikoku, Rokko and Izumi Katsuragi districts.
