## Top-Up Payment for Fixed-Amount Tax Reduction Shortfalls

If the amount paid to you under the Initial Adjustment Payment in FY2024 was insufficient, an additional payment will be made. **Context Note:** In summer 2024, advance payments had been made to people who were expected to have a shortfall in their fixed-amount tax reduction. These payments were calculated using the estimated shortfall amount at that time.

#### Who May Be Eligible

Residents of Wakayama City as of January 1, 2025 to whom I or II applies:

- I. A shortfall arose in the amount paid as the Initial Adjustment Payment in 2024. (After your 2024 income tax and your actual fixed-amount tax reduction, etc. were finalized, there was a difference between the amount that should have been paid and the amount actually paid.)
- **II.** You may be eligible if you were outside the scope of the fixed-amount tax reduction and did not receive the separate benefit for low-income households, and both of the following apply:
- %For both your 2024 income tax and FY2024 Individual Inhabitant Tax (income-based levy), the tax amount before the fixed-amount reduction is ¥0; and
- \*For tax purposes, you are not treated as a "dependent relative" (e.g., you are a family employee of a blue-return taxpayer, or a family employee of a non-blue-return taxpayer (white-return), or your total income amount exceeds ¥480,000.).

#### **Payment Amount**

- Category I: [Required amount at Shortfall Adjustment Payment] [Required amount at Initial Adjustment Payment]
- Category II (standard): ¥40,000 ※For example, those who moved to Japan from overseas in 2024, or those who were claimed as a dependent relative and received a ¥10,000 reduction based on their FY2024 Individual Inhabitant Tax status—the payment is ¥30,000 (or another amount not equal to ¥40,000).

What You Need to Do: In August, people who may be eligible will be contacted by mail:

- ①If you receive a postcard notice  $\rightarrow$  In general, no action is required.
- ②If you receive a letter with a confirmation form → Complete it and return it.

- Application form: September 30 (Tue), 2025

# **HPV Vaccination (Cervical Cancer Prevention Vaccine)**

Up to 90% of cervical cancers can be prevented with vaccination. If you are in the high school first-year age group, please start your first dose by around September, as it takes about six months to complete the 3-dose series.

- ▼Eligibility: Girls of the age group from Grade 6 through first-year of high school ▼Doses: 2 or 3 doses
- ▼Cost: Free ▼How to get vaccinated: Book an appointment with a medical institution and bring your Maternal and Child Health Handbook and prevaccination questionnaire.

This is the annual update to confirm eligibility and income status. If you do not submit this report, you will not be able to receive the allowance for November and thereafter.

▼Submission Period: Fri Aug 1 – Fri Aug 29 ▼Who Must Submit: All current recipients of the allowance (incl. those whose payments are fully suspended) ▼How to Submit: Bring the required documents. The recipient must come in person to complete the procedure. If five years have elapsed since you first began receiving the allowance, please also submit the designated "Notification of Grounds for Exemption from Partial Suspension of the Child-Rearing Allowance" and related documents.

## FY 2025 National Census

A Survey of All People and Households Living in Japan

The national census is Japan's most important statistical survey, conducted once every five years. All people and households (as well as foreign residents) living in Japan are included.

### From mid-September

Census enumerators with official ID badges will survey their assigned areas.

### From late-September

Enumerators will visit each household to deliver the questionnaire. At that time, they may ask a few simple questions, such as your name and the number of people in your household, so please cooperate. You can complete the census online (smartphones may be used), or submit by mail.
